Ambulance Strike Team Leader Course

This course is offered to meet the trainee level requirements for the California Emergency Medical Services Agency (EMSA) Ambulance Strike Team Leader (ASTL) position. Students will participate in a 16-hour, two day class utilizing a group learning model to prepare them to respond in a leadership role on an ambulance strike team or medical task force. The course is approved for 16 hours of continuing education credits for EMT-1B and EMT-P and one AHC college unit.
